






Right and Front View with EMC Plate



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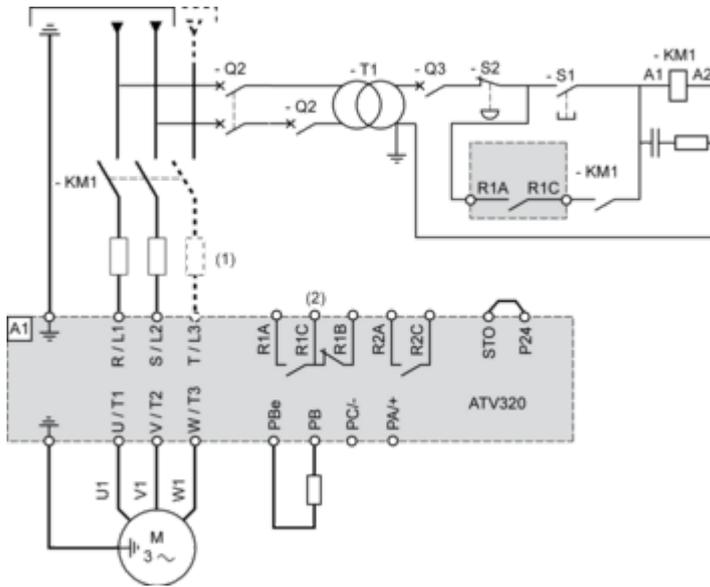



Single or Three-phase Power Supply - Diagram With Line Contactor




- (1) Line choke (if used)


Control Block Wiring Diagram






Switch Set to SRC (Source) Position Using the Output Power Supply for the Digital Inputs




Switch Set to SRC (Source) Position and Use of an External Power Supply for the Digital Inputs

- To avoid triggering the STO function when switching-on the product, the external power supply must be previously switched on.



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Derating curve for the nominal drive current ( $I_n$ ) as a function of temperature and switching frequency (SF).




- 40 °C (104 °F) - Mounting type A, B and C


